## Career Pathways

Career Pathway courses allow juniors and seniors the opportunity to take college courses while still in high school. Students who complete the course will earn high school and college credit. These courses are known as dual credit courses.

Students may take a sequence of college courses while in high school, which could lead to a CCC certificate upon completion.

CCC tuition applies to Career Pathway courses. Tuition assistance may be available, check with your school counselor.

Listed below are Career Pathway courses currently available at your school. Certain pathways may change due to course curriculum updates.

### Career Pathway Courses

At this time, Clarkson does not participate in any Career Pathway courses. Ask your school counselor if any of these Career Pathways could be offered at your school.

College classes are taught on-line, televised, lecture, lab, or face-to-face instruction either in the high school or at our campuses and centers.

Students are required to take a pre-enrollment assessment of Accuplacer or ACT. Check with your guidance counselor for current minimum acceptance scores.

Transferability of Early College courses are determined by the receiving institution. Central Community College transcripts can be sent to any college upon the student's request.

## General Education

General Education courses allow juniors and seniors the opportunity to take college courses while still in high school. Students will earn high school and college credit at the same time. These courses are known as dual credit courses.

CCC tuition applies to General Education courses. Tuition assistance may be available, check with your school counselor.

Listed below are General Education courses currently available at your school. In addition, Clarkson students may also choose from a variety of online courses to work toward a degree at CCC or for transfer to another college.
