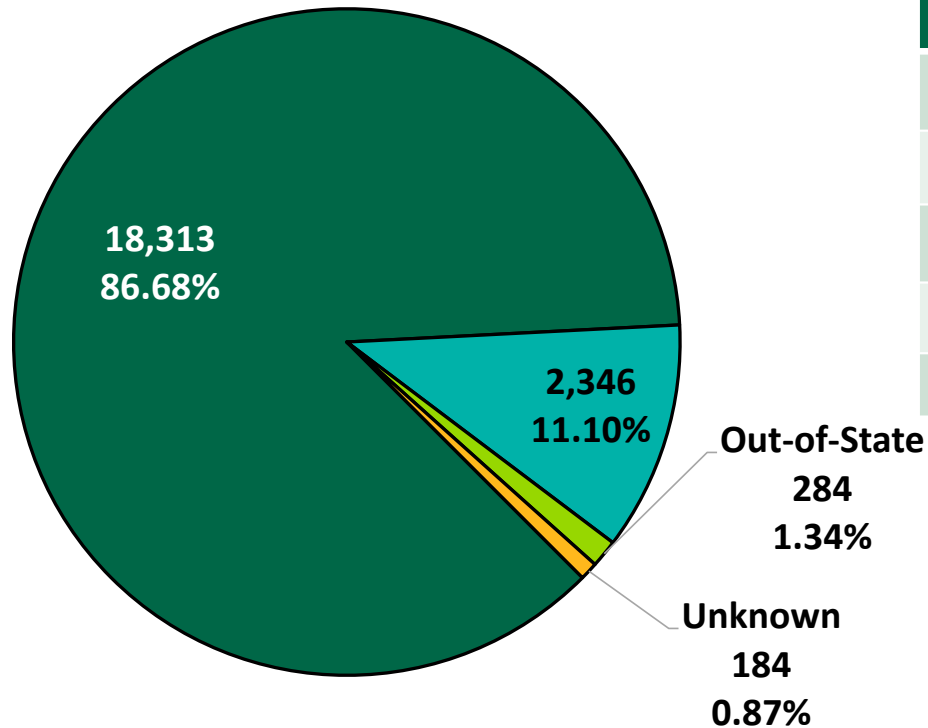

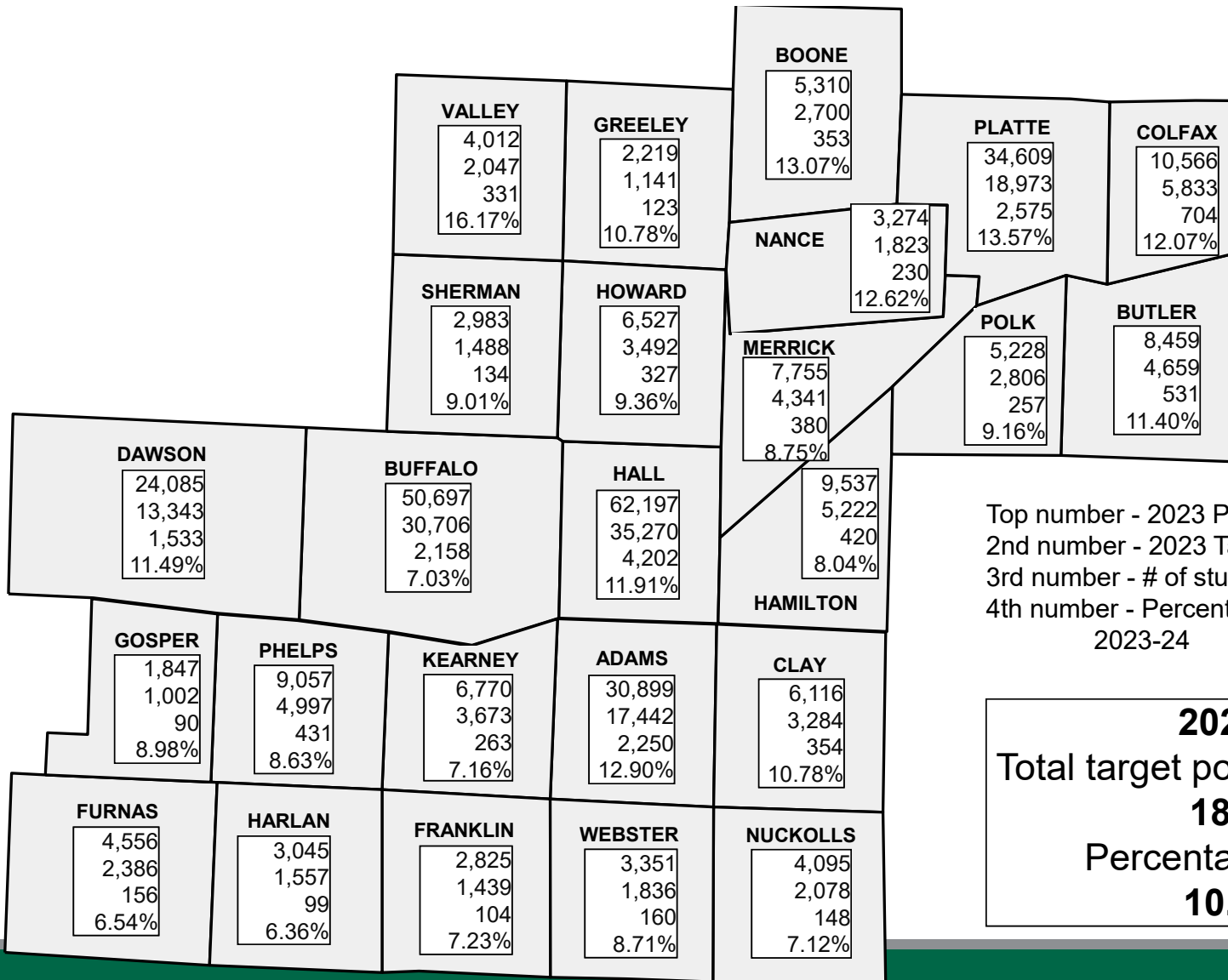

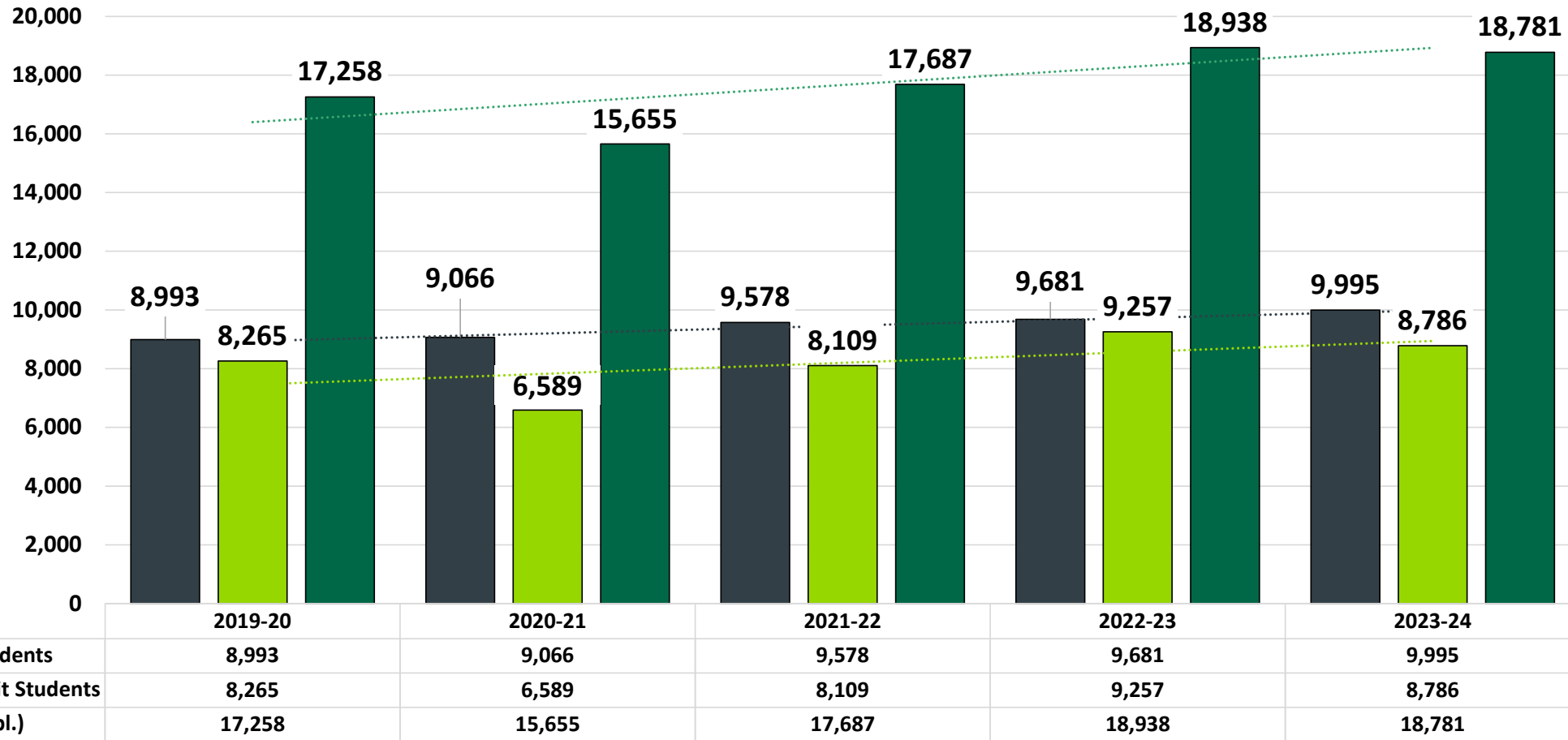

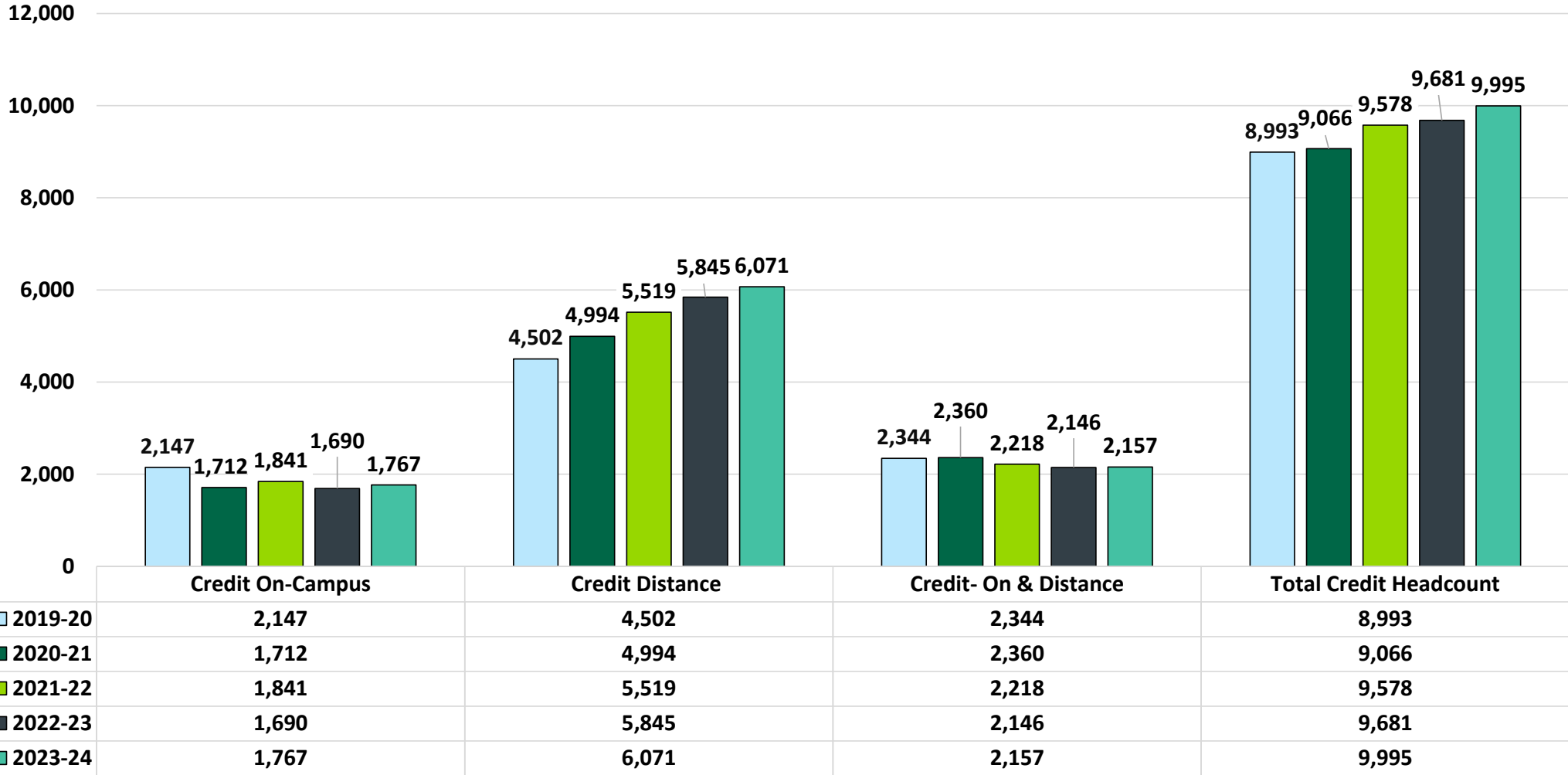

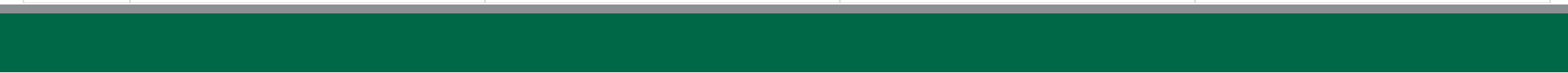
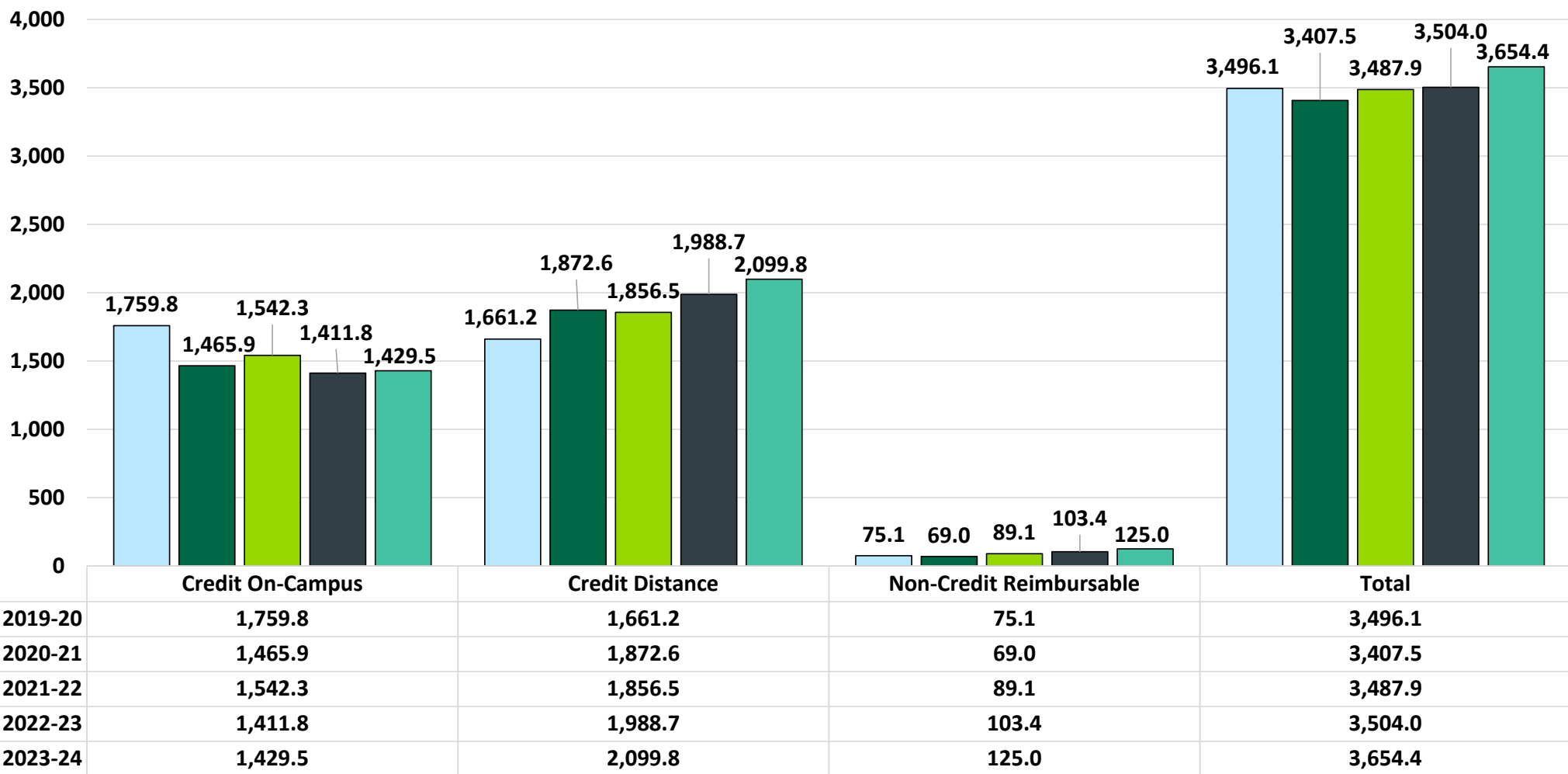

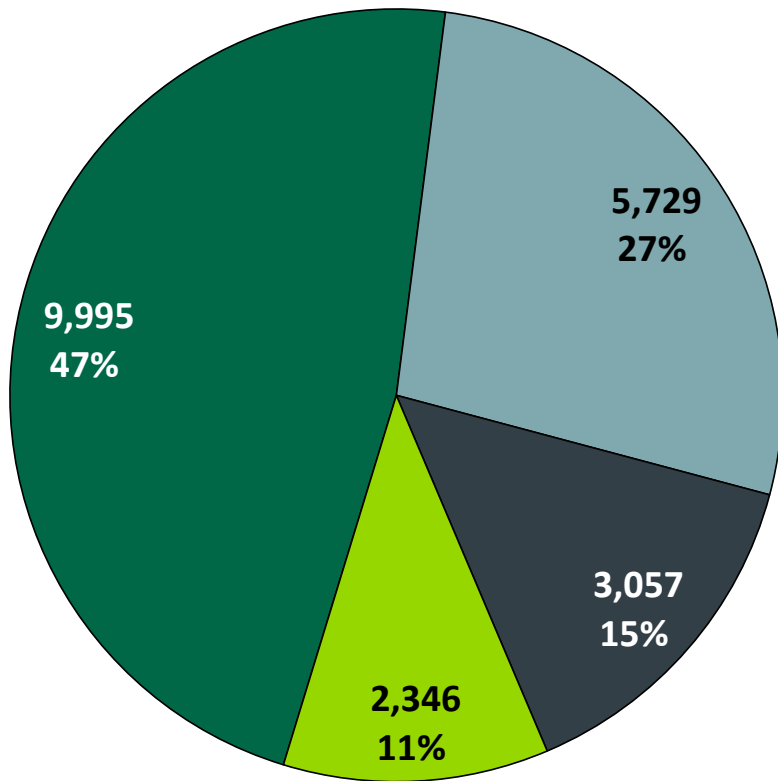
Unduplicated Headcount Of Credit Students By Type Of Delivery

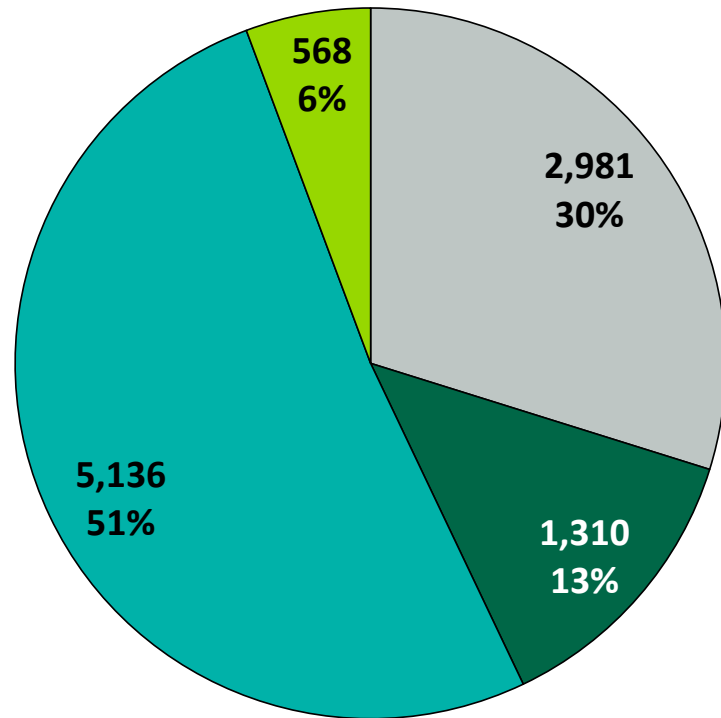

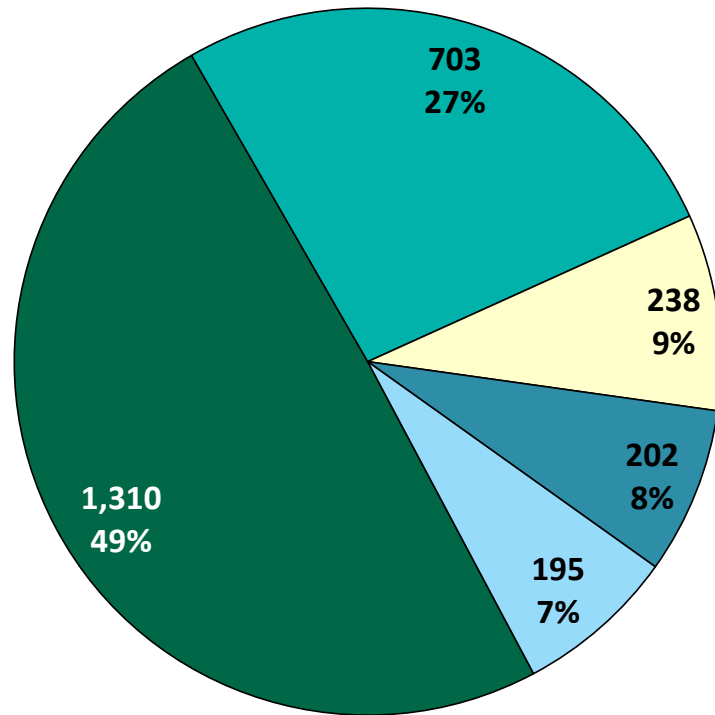

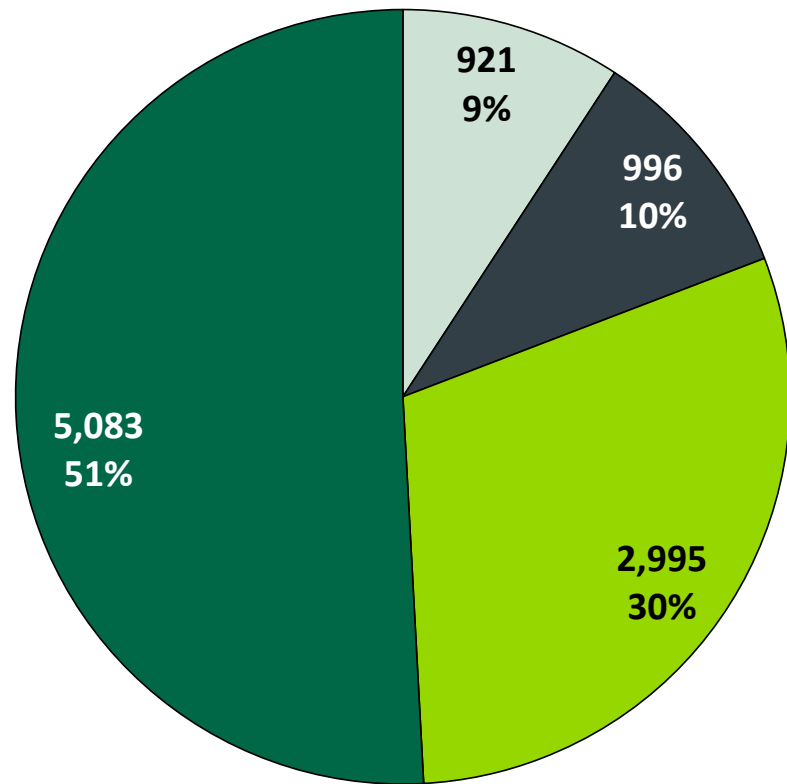

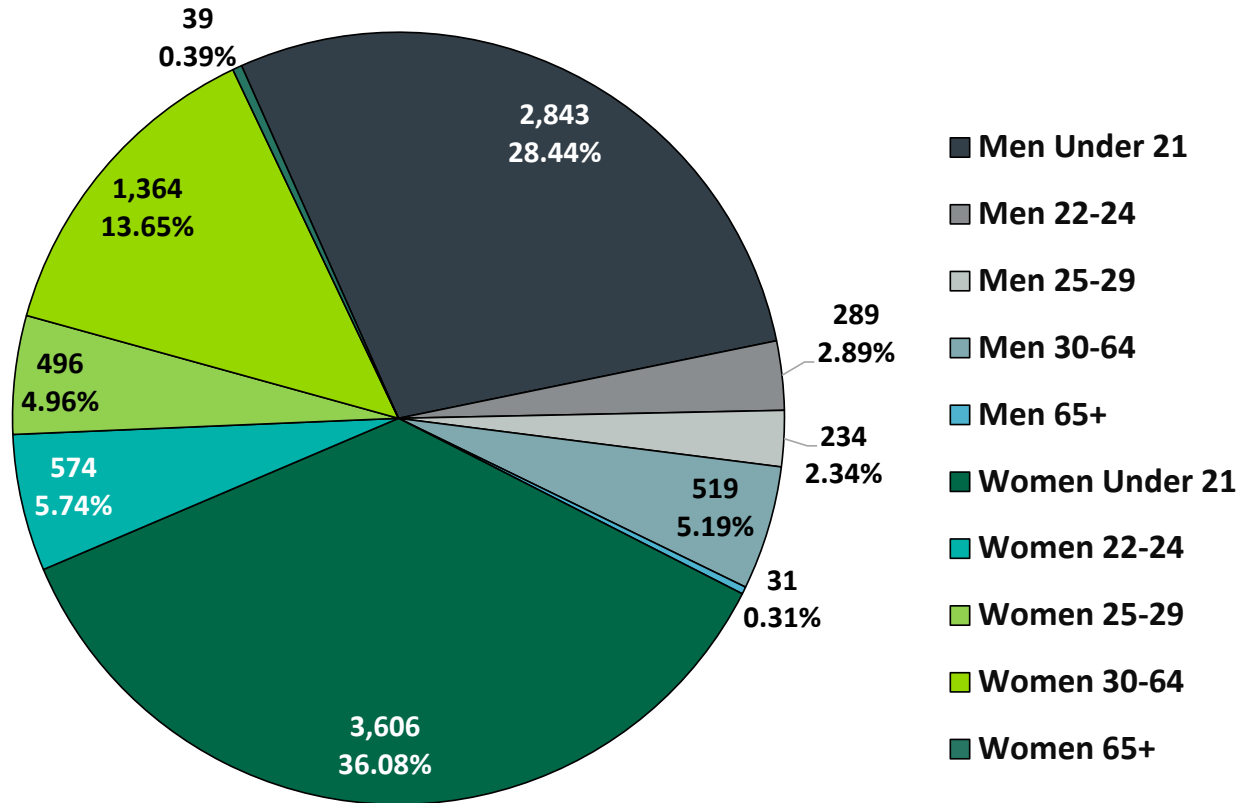

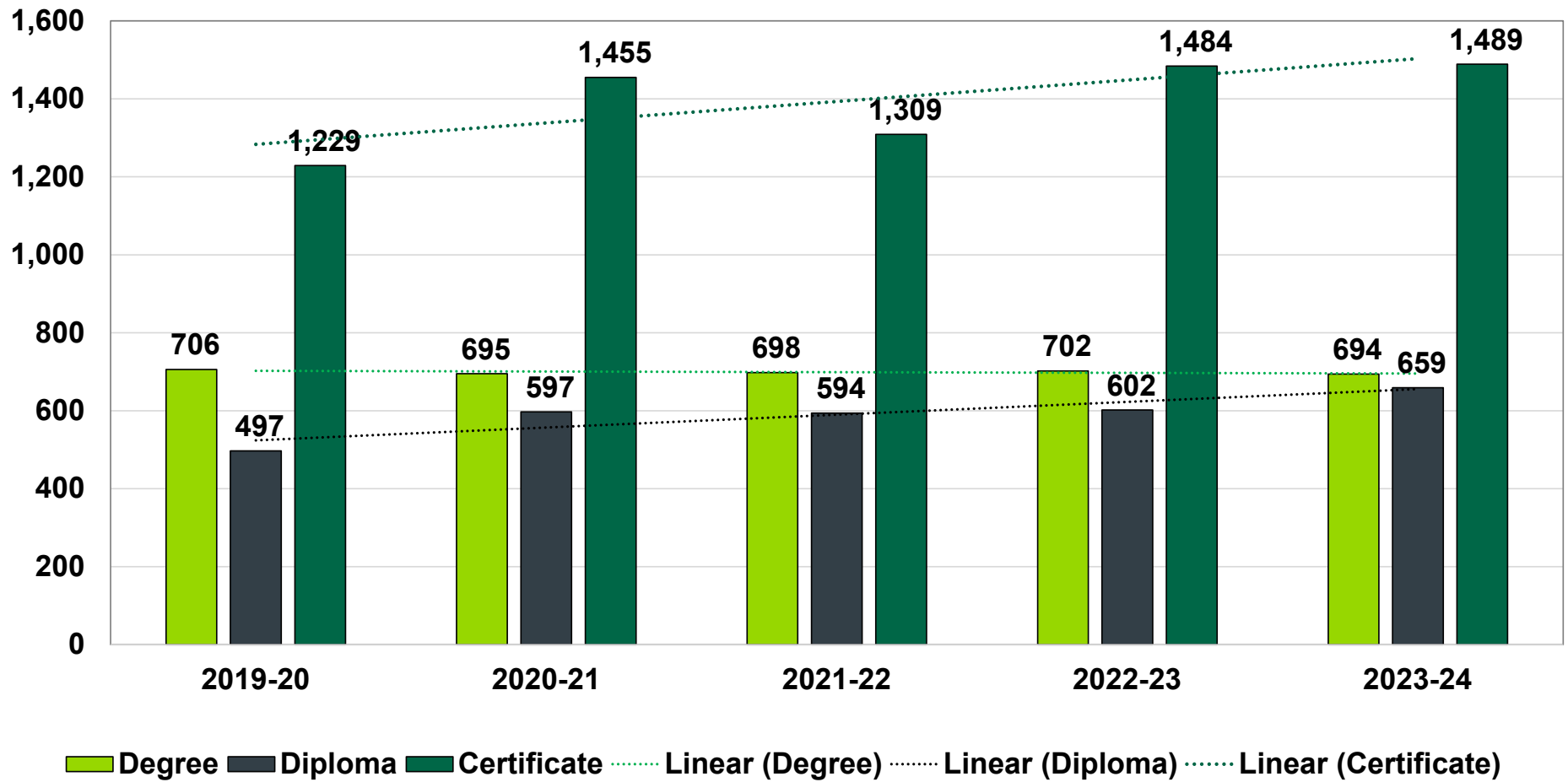

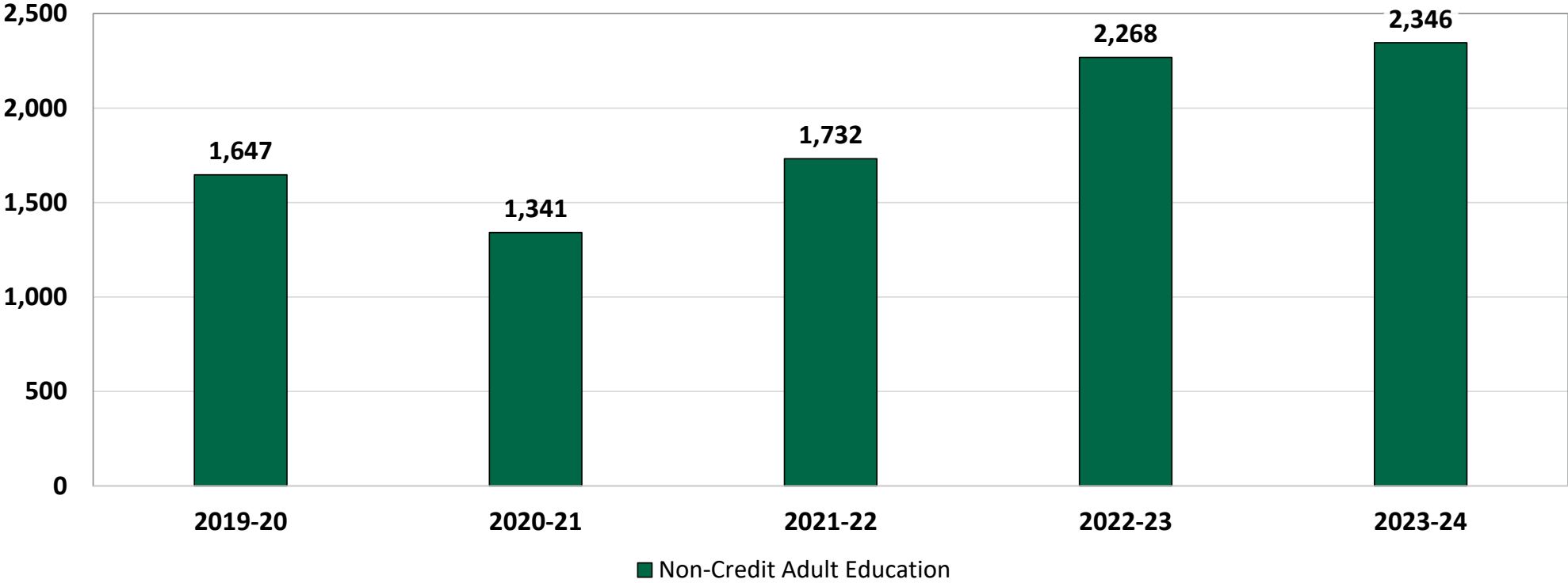
