ON-THE-JOB TRAINING (OJT) COMPETENCIES:

- Assist motorists or pedestrians.
- Confiscate prohibited or dangerous items.
- Detain suspects or witnesses.
- Escort prisoners to courtrooms, prisons, or other facilities.
- Record crime or accident scene evidence with video or still cameras.
- Determine operational procedures.
- Record information about suspects or criminals.
- Communicate situation details to appropriate personnel.

- Maintain public order and security.
- Investigate accidents to determine causes.
- Testify at legal or legislative proceedings.
- Patrol properties to maintain safety.
- Direct law enforcement activities.
- Serve courts ordered documents.

- Administer first aid.
