- **Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2025-26 school year.** We have many scholarships that are need-based. We cannot determine your eligibility for those scholarships without your FAFSA. Our school code is 014468.
- **Follow application instructions.** Be sure to read the question carefully before answering.
- **Write a great essay.** A well-written essay can be your ticket to standing out in the crowd. If you don't have great writing skills, consider working with your advisor or attending a writing workshop to help you. A good essay will generally be 250-400 words.
- **You can make corrections or updates on your application after you have submitted it.** Please be sure this is completed before the application due date.

PLEASE NOTE

1. Current CCC students should complete the scholarship application that is due on or before March 1st.
2. Priority will be given to NEW CCC students after the March 1st due date.
3. We will consider only one application per student for the academic year.
4. All scholarships require that students register for **at least 6 credits per semester**, unless otherwise noted.

Hints for writing a captivating scholarship essay:

1. Carefully read the scholarship requirements
2. Start with a brief outline and brainstorm ideas
3. Be very creative and honest in your examples
4. Make certain your opening paragraph grabs the reader's attention
5. Strive for at least three supporting paragraphs with specific examples
6. Use strong word choice and sentence variety
7. Do not start your concluding paragraph with "In conclusion..."
8. Write a powerful concluding paragraph that summarizes your thesis and circles back to your creative opening paragraph
9. Proofread carefully for grammar, spelling and punctuation errors
10. Have someone else proofread your essay
11. Write a thoughtful thank-you letter when you receive a scholarship
