



BAS in Public Safety Administration/Administration of Justice Transfer Guide (3 year / 92 credits)

Completion of the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree at Central Community College satisfies all general education requirements at Yavapai College as a General Education Block transfer.

Through lower-division coursework, students may transfer additional Central Community College credits to satisfy lower-division requirements at Yavapai College. The remaining lower and upper-division requirements are to be completed at Yavapai College.
