

BAS in Public Safety Administration/Paramedicine Transfer Guide (3 year / 93 credits)

Completion of the Paramedicine Associate of Applied Science degree at Central Community College with State Licensure or National Registry EMT (paramedic) satisfies all lower-division requirements at Yavapai College.

Through general education coursework, students may transfer additional Central Community College credits as general education requirements at Yavapai College. The remaining upper-division requirements are to be completed at Yavapai College.
